Synopsis:

This is a report on Islamic State of Iraq fighters and equipment that crossed the border in Sector 1 from 15 March 2006 to 16 September 2006.

Key Themes:

Eighty-nine fighters and potential martyrs entered Iraq in Sector 1 from 15 March 2006, when Abu 'Abdallah al-Ansari took charge of Border Sector 1, to 16 September 2006, when Abu Muthanna took over. Twenty left. Ten rolls of what is probably cortex, 19 timers, two cameras, and three laptops were distributed to various areas. Abu Husayn is the Border Emir.

Summary: This document is the final page of a report from Abu-Husayn, border emir for the Islamic State of Iraq, describing the activity of border sector 1 between 15 MAR and 16 SEP 2006, including the movement of 89 people [TC: mostly martyrs and fighters] and various equipment into Iraq and the departure of 20 brothers. It also lists equipment arriving to locations in Iraq, such as 10 rolls of quartz [TC: phonetic; possibly cortex detonation cord] to Ar Ramadi, 19 clocks transferred to Abu-Qassurah, a camera to Mosul and a camera to Kirkuk, and three laptops to each of Tall'Afar, Mosul, and Abu-Qassurah. The report is witnessed by Shahin, the administrator for the border sector, Abu-'Abdallah al-Ansari, the former official of border sector 1, and Abu-Muthanna al-Ansari, the current official of border sector 1. The time period given reflects the date 15 MAR 2006 as the day Abu-'Abdallah al-Ansari took over [TC: the official in charge of border sector 1] and 16 SEP 2006 as the day Abu-Muthanna took over.

With regards to those brethren [TC: synonymous with “mujahidin” in the context of this document] who are entering and departing Iraq, they are as follows: 89 martyrdom seekers and combatants coming into Iraq, although the ones slated for carrying out martyrdom operations have not yet been separated from the combatants. Among them was a family of six children and one woman.

There are 20 brethren departing Iraq.

As for the incoming explosives, there are 10 rolls of quartz [TC: possibly cortex detonation cord] being brought to Ar Ramadi and 19 timers that have been transported to Abu-Qassurah [TC: alternate spelling: Abu-Qasurah], two cameras—one being brought to Mosul and the other to Abu-Qassurah, and three laptop computers—one to Tall'Afar, the second to Mosul, and the third to Abu-Qassurah.

This is the report from border sector 1 as of Abu-'Abdallah al-Ansari's assumption of command on 15 March 2006 till Abu-Muthanna's taking over on 16 September 2006.
