The speech of Sheikh Osama:

The regular (periodic) meeting held on Wednesday after Al-'ASR prayers:

The past periods:

(Future issues – Events acceleration).

- The stand of government from the Jihad movement (slowing and then rising in the Jihad action in Afghanistan).
- The acceleration of events after the quantitative operation (created a reaction in the entire Islamic world), the people began to look for help from Afghanistan with God assistance and movement to save and

- rescue the nation. From here and with this action we succeeded in mobilizing the efforts and capabilities.
- We expect huge waves within few months. Everyone is required to participate to their fullest by advising and cooperating within the charts of organization. Charts have been prepared to suite future events and the resulting disciplines.
- Treat the matter as if we are an Islamic government in exile, we moved from the phase of potentiality to the phase of expansion and preparedness and large responsibilities.
- Correspondences must be in writing; incoming and outgoing mail; discipline in appointments.

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In The Name Of God the Merciful the Compassionate Without doubt, the Moslem began to rise from their inadvertence and stumble. If we wish to be steadfast and advancement, we must monitor the march, figure the gaps and block it; diagnose the illnesses and treat them. Dear brothers,

The mention of illnesses and mistakes never mean putting someone down. Look at The All Mighty God admonishing His Prophet Muhammed and his companions in more than one instant in the Holy Koran, and he mentioned their violations in the battles of Uhod and Hunayn. Then there is the Prophet repeatedly mentioning the illnesses and what would happen to this nation because of it. He does not mention the illness except to find the cures for it. Therefore, our goal if the illness is described or the failure is mentioned is two things:

First: Increase the trust in God and that He never break His promise in achieving victory to the faithful. On the contrary, we did not do our part.

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Second: Know the actual reasons behind our weakness and failure. Giving advice is obedience to God and leads to consensus. Adulation is a sin, which causes dissension and torment. We must understand that we are humans, we make mistakes, and know right from wrong, we experience

pleasure and anger, and we are not infallible. Knowing this fact makes the treatment easy and available.

If we diagnose the illness, we must know its real and exact size without exaggeration. Also, it is urgent to cure the illness before it spreads and becomes hard for us to treat.

There are in this place people who gathered to gain money, tribal power, a Ministry or to rule an Imarah; we gathered here to please the Almighty God and defend the faith of Islam. So let us defend Islam with ourselves so God will give us victory over the infidels.

Everyone I see in front of me here is praying to God to be a martyr defending Islam.

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We would be extinct if we did not stay in touch with our relatives on the maternal side. Do you know our position in the day of resurrection? You can find the answer in the Prophet tradition narrated by Abu Malik Al-Ash'ari, when he gathered the tribe of Ash'aris and taught them prayers as performed by the Prophet Muhammed in Al-Madinah Al-Munawarah. When he finished praying, he turned to his people and said learn the way I performed the prayers, it is the way the Prophet peace be upon him performed it. Who when finished turned his face towards the people and said, listen and understand and realize that God has people other than prophets and martyrs served and pleased by prophets and martyrs in their living quarters and closeness from God. A Bedouin man approached the Prophet, raised his hand and said, people from the people not prophets nor martyrs served and pleased by Prophets and martyrs in their living quarters and closeness from God?

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Please describe them to us. The Prophets' face was lit with delight for the Bedouins' question and said: "They are people of extinct people and strangers of the tribes who did not stay in touch with their relatives on the maternal side. They new mutual love in God and became sincere. In the day of resurrection God will make for them platforms of light and will seat them on it. He will make their faces of light, scare the people on the day of resurrection but they will not be scared. They will be the saints of God never fearing, never saddened.

Is there a better advantage? How is it for he who combines this advantage and the advantage of martyrdom? It will be indeed a great honor. I pray that God bestow this honor on us all.

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The one who advises you does not become your enemy if you don't accept his advice and said I am rewarded by God.

The difference between the advice and backbiting is that the advice is meant to warn the Moslem of an individual's bad characteristics such the time the Prophet advised his daughter Fatimah on whether to marry Mu'awiyah or Abu Juham. He replied by saying that Mu'awiyah is a miserable, spineless individual; and as far as Abu Juham is concerned, he does not put his cane where he wishes. Some of his friend who traveled with him (Abu Juham) added to be aware of him if you meet him away from his tribe.

If backbiting occurs but meant to be an advice to serve Islam and Moslems then it is a good deed. On the other hand if it is meant to put down your Moslem brother then it is considered one of the great sins mentioned in the Holy Koran.

Mu'ammar Bin Rashid Bin Humam Al-San'ani said, "The best one to give you advice is the one who fears God in you".

The late Bin Rajab said, "The advisor has no purpose in spreading the defects of the person he is advising, but to eliminate the problem he is experiencing. Therefore, the advisor must have mercy on his brothers and his nation, and adopt a wise method in giving his advice".

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The late Misfir Bin Kidam said, "God bless the person who presents me with my faults in secret, advice in the open is considered scolding. If the advice was private and circulated, then it is reprimand. The late Bin Al-Qayem says in the book entitled "Al-Rouh (Soul) and the Difference between the Advice and Reprimand". The advice is a beneficence to the person we are advising in a picture of pity and mercy on him. It is pure beneficence deriving from pure mercy and the advisor goal is to please God only.

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One of the differences between the advisor and the reprimanded is to be a secret between the commander and the commanded. As for the rumor and spreading the faults, it is what God and His Prophet have forbidden. It also applies to those who prefer spreading atrocity among the faithful.

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In the Name of God the Merciful the Compassionate

Verses of the Koran:

"Oh you the faithful, be God fearing as you should, and don't face death without being Moslems".

"Oh people be God fearing who created you of one soul, then created many men and women. Be God fearing, whom you question and the wombs, God is always watching you".

"Oh you the faithful be God fearing and always say the truth, He will make your deeds righteous and forgive your sins. He who obeys God will achieve the great victory".

"Wal'asr, the humans are the losers except for the faithful who did the good deeds and advised each other with truth and patience".

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In the beginning of this Sura, The Almighty God swears in one of His creations (He has the right to swear in any of His creations), Al-'ASR in this case and says that the human race is a loser but excluded only those who have the following four characteristics: (Faith, good deeds, advise others with the truth and patience). The late Al-Shafi'i said, "If the people carefully considered this Sura, it could have embraced them.

Al-Tabari said in the meaning of (advised each other with truth and patience). They advised each other to adhere to God words in the Holy Koran.

The truth lies in the book of God, and the advice on patience means that they advise each other to act on the obedience of God.

Al-Naysabouri said in the word "Al-Tawasi" (Advice) without Prayer or Advice is eloquent confirmation as if it is an important matter such as the last will and testament.

Advice is a matter Moslems are keen on. Its existence in any society is evidence of the right path, and the will of affluence, usefulness and righteousness for all is the dominant sprit.

The advice should not be a reaction to specific moment, or ignored over time until mistakes and incidents are accumulated. Our goal should always be advice and not being courteous to each other.

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The advice is usually given for God, His Prophet, the Holy Koran, the Moslem Scholars and common Moslems too. Tameem Bin Ous Al-Dari Narrated from the Prophet that he said,"Faith is Advice. We said to whom? He said, "To God, His Book, His Prophet, the Moslem Scholars and their commons".

In his book entitled "Tayseer Al-Kareem Al-Rahman", Sheikh 'Abd Al-Rahman Al-Sa'adi says," Advice to God and His Prophet is in true faith, and sincere intention on jihad with resolve when able and do the necessary to encourage Moslems to join jihad.

In explaining the meaning of advice to Moslem Scholars/Imams, Bin Hajar says, "Advising Moslem scholars is to assist them in their tasks, and caution them when negligent, support them when they make a mistake, and gather the people around them. Giving them good advice means keeping them away from injustice in a friendly manner.

Giving advice Moslem result in many benefits, here are some of it: The advice is the essence of religion and faith, and the sign of wishing good and detesting evil for others.

- Q1- I swear to God I love you Abu 'Abdullah. We need from you dear Sheikh to explain the corruption and ignorance criterion, because some of our brothers argue that according to these two factors the Saudi rulers are not infidels.
- Q2- Is the mere thinking of participation in martyrdom operations is sufficient for the freedom fighter not to participate in the seminars that qualify him to enroll in the battalions and companies? (TC: These battalions and companies are being formed and prepared to carryout martyrdom [terrorist] operations).
- Q3- Standing an hour in line defending the faith is better than the night of Al-Qadr at the black stone (the Ka'aba in Mecca). How true is this Prophet tradition, knowing that the night of Al-Qadr is worth better than 83 years? Please inform us, and thank you.

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Questions/ lecture on the way to prudent and wise caliphate. Date: September 21, 2000.

- Q1- What is your opinion in those who execute actions and threaten the Americans in the Arabian Peninsula, and if you advise him to join a group like yours for example and he replies I prefer to be on my own?
- Q2- What is the ruling on killing innocent Moslems in terrorist operations, is the person executing the operation responsible for their death or not? What are the detail results of the Al-Kharj terrorist operation?
- Q3- We often hear the Brothers talk about Yemen and its people, and the available weapons there in low prices. The youth in Yemen are idle and do

not work. If this weapon is available to us we will be able to do plenty, until something happens inside the youth in Yemen and some are willing to do some missions and kill Christians or destroy the strongholds of corruption. This information comes particularly from the instructors from Yemen. What is your advice to the youth in Yemen, should they begin working, please explain and give advice to all?

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- Q4- We heard many of the youth who pledged the legend to you, please explain the legend process, and on what the pledge the legend?
- Q5- Sheikh Osama Bin Laden God bless you, are we going to open the new front against the Russians soon?
- Q6- Is it true that Abu Al-Hasan Al-Mihdhar was executed or not? If he was, why don't you seek revenge from God's enemies, why, why?
- Q7- What are the available methods to us for fighting the Americans? And what are the solution to lift the occupation off the Arabian Peninsula?
- Q8- I am a young man with little education in the faith matters. What is your advice to me after completing the preparatory seminar, continue the education or look to join frontlines?
- Q9- What is our duty today towards Islam and the nation of Islam after being prepared and we are ready to do anything? Please show us the way.
- Q10- Who is the leader of Al-Maharah (Muhammed Burhanuddin) who claims to be a God being worshiped in Yemen, and what is the duty of the youth in Yemen towards ...?

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- Q11- In respect to our Brothers who are imprisoned in the United States and other infidel countries, are there attempts or hope to release them such as sheikh 'Omar 'Abd Al-Rahman, Ramzi Yousef and others?
- Q12- The U. S. naval bases, is there a plan to fight it, and how could I work in this field?

Q13- What is the best way to convince the scholars who are in conflict with the freedom fighters and the people to join us?

- Q1- Is it true that there are seminars and companies being prepared to fight against the United States, and would we have a role to participate in it? - Q3- I migrated here to join the freedom fighters to defend the word of God and the Moslem nation but I always had to worry about how to take care of myself financially because I have no income. Do you have a solution for this problem?
- Q4- Please give and explain some of the reasons that assist in breaking down the psychological barrier facing the youth in confronting the enemies of God.
- Q5- Some people are discrediting religious scholars such as the late Sheikh 'Abd Al-'Aziz Bin Baz due to some of their Fatwa's such as the peace treaties with Israel and seeking the assistance from the infidels. Is this action a reason to treat them as such?

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- Q6- What is your opinion of fighting on the side of the Taliban against Mas'oud? What is the ruling on the group of Ahmed Shah Mas'oud, many say they are Moslems and those of them killed are martyrs and will be delivered to Heaven. What is your answer?
- Q7- When does Jihad become an individual duty in all Moslem faiths?
- Q8- Dear sheikh, I wish to visit my family, does the basic course waves the Jihad preparation course, what do you advise me to do?
- Q9- Is the killing of the civilian infidel and also that who surrenders permitted?
- Q10- What is the ruling on martyrdom operations?
- Q11- What is the ruling on fighting on the side of Taliban if the parents are against Jihad keeping in mind that some people say fighting with them is preparation? Please explain.

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Q12- Which has priority, Jihad against the infidels or paying the debts first?

- Q13- Is it legal to get rid of the Al-Mejkarimah (Al-Qaramitah) group by placing poison in the water tank because they cursed and defamed the Companions of the Prophet?
- Q14- A man asked his only son to care for his two sisters and do everything to make the happy. Knowing that they are married, should the son execute his father's request or is he free to join the Jihad movement?
- Q15- Give a proof from the Koran and Sunna that mention fighting the oppressors.
- Q16- how do you combine the Prophet forbidding the killing of women and children and him permitting stabilization of the enemy and erecting the catapult over them?
- Q17- What is the ruling on killing the priests of the churches?
- Q18- What is the ruling on fighting the infidels if mingled with Moslem prisoners of war?
- Q19- What is the ruling on war spy if he surrenders peacefully or otherwise?

- To date they are talking about deeming us weak and that it is not the time for Jihad now.

We ought to remind the scholars and scientists and people of the Islamic world that we are still in existence on the same Afghani soil.

Speech on the conviction of the oppressed, and comparison with Badr battle.

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Session dated 19/05/1421H

In attendance:

Continued dialogue about the Jaji battle:

Evidence of the incidents and battles to benefit from it and awaken the Moslem nations that imagined the defeat and purchased for our generations.

- The Soviet Union was a great power, and the poor, sheep herder Afghanis inherited old automatic rifles they used to fight the British. Some freedom fighters sell some sheep to purchase few rounds of ammunition.
 - 26,000 modern tanks facing few tens of shoeless Afghanis. Faith could not be understood by all the tanks and modern weapons on this earth if the man put his faith in God.
- During 1986 (1406H and the beginning of 1497H) over 50,000 Russians were killed in Afghanistan. God is my witness that the symbols of the movement at the beginning of the war were looking astonishingly towards us. During some meeting, they were saying loudly do you really think you will achieve victory over the Russians? The reply by leaders in the Arabian Gulf to leaders of the Afghani Jihad when they requested their assistance was you are crazy, who fights the Russians?

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(E) Questions by the Tactics Group (Mountain Tactics). Dated: 01/05/1421H

Q1- Please talk to us about the Jihad in Uzbekistan and when did it begin, we need the news?

- Q2- What is the ruling on Jihad on the side of the Taliban?
- Q3- What is the ruling on monies and properties of the governments?
- Q4- Is there a possibility to fight on the side of Taliban in Konduz?
- Q5- I owe some debt to Moslems back home and I came to the land of Jihad after a friend promised to pay this debt. I don't know whether he did or not. Should I go to the frontline or not because I am not sure of this matter? Q6- What do advice a person who completed all the seminars and trainings?
- Q7- Is the end of Mas'oud is almost here according to your knowledge of the situation?
- Q8- Is there any evidence on the martyrdom operations?
- Q9- There are infidels in Pakistan and India of Christians and others. Is it ok for us to kill them and take their possessions and properties? Is it ok to steal from the infidels residing the Islamic and non Islamic countries?

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(D) Questions from the Camp during the period from 07/04 – 12/04/1421H

- Q1- What is the news about the battalions you are preparing? Do we have a role to play in it or not? We asked our instructors but no one gave an answer in this matter? (TC: These battalions are being formed and prepared to carryout martyrdom [terrorist] operations).
- Q2- Would you find all you can about the Uzbek front and the latest news about the Taliban Front?
- Q3- I know that we are on the side of justice, why is the delay in acting and moving to serve this religion? Why does the infidels work to destroy this religion and we do nothing to preserve it?

- Q5- Dear Sheikh, through the infiltration of the rejection movement whose the advisor of King Fahad for the past 20 years is one of them, there are (18) female teachers of the same movement in a small village without male companions living in one apartment. They teach in the morning and commit sins at night. Please take a look at the Shiite plans in the Gulf and Holy land region?
- Q6- After listening to these words, what is our duty towards the occupation of the Holy land (Saudi Arabia) and do we unify to save the most sacred places on earth? We are ready to work instead of returning home and forget what we trained on and go back to life we used to live.
- Q8- We heard that you had a conversation with Sheikh Bin 'Otheimeen who arrived safely to the land of Jihad about the presence of Christian forces in the Islamic Peninsula, Please explain?

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- Q9- We heard there is consensus related by 'Abd Al-Qader Bin 'Abd Al-'Aziz about making unbeliever the supporters of the infidels, what are you directives particularly that the Prophet fought all the infidels?
- Q10- Which is more accurate to say the Arabian Peninsula or the Islamic Peninsula because the cause is the cause of all Moslems?
- Q11- You mentioned that of the conditions to join the freedom fighters companies under preparation now that the young man must be physically strong while the Prophet says in this regard, "You achieve victory with the help of your weak"?
- Q12- Dear Sheikh, what is your opinion of a person who only completes the basic training course then returns to his home country but meaning to immediately come back when a new front is opened, Uzbekistan or others for example?
- Q13- In a previous lecture you gave a summary about the conditions of our brothers in Iraq and what they are experiencing of oppression by the Americans. What is the duty of the freedom fighters towards their brothers in Iraq?

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- Q14- Does the freedom fighter faces his creator in his tomb if he goes out for Jihad and dies as a result of a snake bite or a kick of mule?
- Q15- You mentioned once that a front will open in Uzbekistan, but we heard nothing about it afterwards. Will this from open soon or not?
- Q16- From the story of Ka'ab Bin Malik concerning dealing with those lagging behind (not joining Jihad), do the same rules apply or there are other rules to deal with them? The other point what is our duty with them?
- Q17- What is the latest news about Al-'Ouhali?
- Q18- We have a Sheikh who incite people on Jihad. He prepares and equips the young men and at the same time cares for the freedom fighter locally and abroad. Is this Sheikh considered one of the lagging behind?
- Q19- Preparation is a collective duty. If I completed the basic training, based on this, am I considered to have fulfilled my duty obligation?

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- Q20- In respect to migration particularly the young men from the Arabian Peninsula. What is your opinion in some of them who say how do we migrate and leave the Holy places for the oppressors, what is your answer to them?
- Q21- I heard from some men who gave everything they own to travel to this camp and then they spend ample time in playing and laughing. I heard them talk about places like Kentucky fried chicken, and McDonalds and remember the old times. We need your advice in this matter?
- Q22- For an individual who says I train in this camp on few courses then return home to my mother, father, wife and children because they are not happy or satisfied with what I am doing, and I have duty towards them too. If a Jihad front is not opened to absorb them, what is your advice to them?
- Q23- You mentioned that the Prophet accompanied with him to battle the scholars, scientists, teachers and students. There was no excuse for anyone

when it came to Jihad. What should we say to our famous scholars who did not participate in the Jihad against Russia in Afghanistan and the days of Serbia in the Bosnia and others?

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Q24- Do we ignore the teachings and science they publish or warn against them? We mean the scholars of the Islamic nation nowadays. Must we fight them the same way we fight the scholars in the Arabian Peninsula?

Q25- Please give us your opinion in a Sheikh who truly incites men on Jihad and assists to prepare them for this purpose?

Q26- We want to join you because we understood that it is an occupation. We can not meet you for fear of putting you in an awkward position. Is there a place we could go to like the administration for example or do you select the meeting place?

Q27- What is the period of time a married man is permitted to stay away from his wife when he is in the preparation phase or the frontline, whether individual or collective duty?

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Q28- Some of the discouraging people came and said why all of this effort and preparation? All you need to know is how to fire the Kalashnikov and enroll in a weapons' course and they are among us now. This is a fact, and I am not saying this to cause trouble for them. What is your answer to them?

Q29- Groups of men in their respective countries are inciting the people on Jihad and explaining the role of the American danger and the danger of the present situation, and what the their infidel supporters are doing to prevent them from arriving to the land of Jihad?

Q30- Dear Sheikh, some people are rushing into making unbelievers of others which we did not hear from a Sheikh or a scholar. These individuals are not in a position to make unbeliever of this or that person. What is your Fatwa in this regard?

- Q31- Dear Sheikh, would you give us a summary of the advantage of pledging the legend to listen and obey you, and what do you want from those who pledge the legend to you?
- Q32- There is a matter the men frequently talk about being making unbelievers the supporters of the oppressors such as the Ministers, the army and others without knowing your personal opinion in this matter?
- Q33- In the story of Ka'ab Bin Malik where he received a letter from the king of (Ghassan) asking him to join him and he won't regret it. When he read the letter, he lit the fire with it and threw it in. Please explain?

Q34- Why is the delay in executing the martyrdom operations against the Americans?

Q35- It is said that the prices of oil in the Arabian Peninsula are rising although the party controlling the prices are the Americans. What is the purpose of this, new American presence? What are the latest news about the sinful King (king Fahad), is he ill moving from one hospital to another, or is he feeling better, we pray to God he dies.

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- Q36- What are the latest news about our brothers in Chechnya?
- Q37- We heard from some news sources that the Sudanese government owes you huge amounts of money and paid only 10%. Is this true? If it is, how are you going to get the rest of your money back?
- Q38- What is the reason for not having new Egyptian freedom fighters amongst us?
- Q39- Why there isn't enough personal weapons (Kalashnikov) in the camp for all the fighters even for self defense, particularly there is a possibility of an attack by global infidel countries on the camp at any time?
- Q40- Is it true that Russian soldiers and American bases exist in Uzbekistan fighting on the side of the Uzbek government? And if a front is opened there, would Jihad be an individual duty?

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Q41- Dear Sheikh, I would like you to mention the benefit or the lesson learned from the letter of the Persian or Roman king to Ka'ab Bin Malik who tore the letter and threw in the fire. The reason for this question is that some of the brothers receive letters from relatives back home and sometimes from a sheikh questioning his judgment for coming to the land of Jihad. Under pressure, the brothers decide to leave and go back home because of such letters. What is your answer and advice?

Q42- Please tell us if you expect a confrontation at the frontline anytime soon, and what are the procedures taken at the frontline now?

Q43- Dear Sheikh, an important question and at the same time it causes a problem and embarrassment among the fighters. What is the ruling on making unbelievers of Al Saud particularly since it has specific regulations, keeping in mind that in the eyes of the people they do nothing that would cast them out of the people? Some of them are hated and some are helpless and powerless like prince 'Abdullah and others, and some are committed the women in particular. We are at a loss, please guide us to the right path.

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Q44- The method of Taliban in fighting against Mas'oud and his allies is well known to you, and all incidents, near and far are witness to it. How long this illiteracy in fighting (defeat after defeat) will last? And does fighting on their side as such considered committing suicide?

Q45- We heard a lot about the (BATTALION) that will be dispatched from Afghanistan, are there news about it, and its destination?

Q46- What is the latest news about our brothers the freedom fighters in Chechnya?

Q47- Are there good news in our Jihad against the global infidel countries?

Q48- You are well informed about the torture of the freedom fighters in the prisons of the Arabian Peninsula by the interrogators. What do you think

about assassinating a number of the interrogators in order to stop them from torturing the freedom fighters for fear from assassination?

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(C) Questions about the lecture of "The Siege of the Mountain Passes" Date: 01/04/1421H

- Q1- Is victory linked to the mountain passes or does it have another role? Please explain.
- Q2- Does the Taliban and their leadership in particular have one stand towards you and your brothers the freedom fighters, or it is the stand of Mullah Muhammed 'Omar and the few around him only?
- Q3- We often hear in some media and through questions directed to some of the Taliban leadership that the Arab freedom fighters are guests in Afghanistan. We don't doubt our Taliban brothers but are we considered in the eyes of the Taliban as residents of this young Islamic State? Or we are Moslems who came to this country and not required to pledge the legend?
- Q4- What is the role of the mountain passes on the road to change? Is entering mountain passes necessary for change? Do you see that staying in Afghanistan is assign of support or advocacy? And is leaving Afghanistan would in anyway bring harm it?

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- Q5- Entering the mountain passes was not limited to the Prophet and his companions but included their families and relatives who were infidels. How could we achieve this knowing that our relatives are Moslems?
- Q6- There is a big problem facing the young men which is making Al Saud unbelievers particularly that this matter is one of the most important in religion. Do we also make unbelievers of them or not?

- Q7- I live in Europe not because I migrated but because I was born there. What is the ruling on stealing their possessions and killing them in their homes?
- Q8- If we complete the training and wish to join you but can not meet with you. Whom should we see or contact for this purpose, otherwise we have no choice but to return home.
- Q9- In previous lectures you apologized on behalf of those who falsely interpret the law. This in no way mean not clarifying right from wrong in the matters of:
 - 1- Reforming corruption.
 - 2- The Da'wa interests and establishments.
 - 3- Inability to resist global infidel countries at the present time.

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- Q10- Do you have a relationship with the freedom fighters in Chechnya whether by financial support or otherwise? Particularly that commander Khattab announced in a press conference that he is not accepting any type of support from you due to the far distance between you and the difficulty in making contact, but he would love to meet you one day?
- Q11- I see men arriving to Afghanistan to be prepared and then return home. Why won't there be frontlines because the men travel back home after completing whatever is available of prep training?
- Q12- What is the reason behind ceasing the martyrdom operations against the Americans? And why don't you approve martyrdom operations in the Holy land (Saudi Arabia)?
- Q13- I have a nephew who commits the big sins but he loves you very much and wishes to join the Jihad movement to atone for his sins. What is the best way to bring him here?
- Q14- The Prophet says, "No migration after the victory etc." (TC: Here he refers to the conquest of Mecca by the Prophet and his companions). Does this tradition indicate that Mecca will remain in the hands of Moslems whether the Arabian Peninsula is under occupation by the Christians as is the case now?

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Q15- Is there a specific period of time in the migration or is it open?

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(B) The Camp Questions during the period from 01/03 to 16/03/1421H

Q1- Dear Sheikh, in previous lectures you were asked how do we get the infidels out of the Arabian Peninsula? We require an answer to this question.

Is attacking the origin takes priority over getting them out such as operations in the United States. God knows that the time has come for action in the branches as you mentioned. At present, we are living the political changes in the personalities and not in the policy that is forced upon them. Is it possible to force them no to ally with the infidels or dismantle these regimes through condensed media campaigns or operations that force them to change their policy against our Moslem brothers in these countries and help them become a power in the state from both the financial and political aspects?

- Q2- Dear Sheikh, we observed that you are a man of politeness, humbleness and bashfulness. What is humbleness and how it is gained?
- Q3- We often hear that you are not fully aware of the camp's organization, and some people say that the instructors act on their own. What is your answer to this accusation?

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- Q4- Dear Sheikh, we learned that the American occupation to the Holy land is a matter that was prepared for previously, and that the Iraqi occupation of Kuwait is only a chapter in this play. Is this true? And what are these conspiracies?
- Q5- Are there clear Prophetic signs indicating that the present time is the beginning of victories and the establishment of Caliphate? And is there

clear evidence now to indicate these signs, and is it tied to specific time, place and personalities?

- Q6- Please give us your vision about the political status in the Arabian Peninsula, and what are your expectations in the event of the death of the present king?
- Q7- What are the latest developments in Uzbekistan?
- Q8- Dear Sheikh, I came to be prepared for Jihad but I did not tell my parents. Am I at fault for not telling them?

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- Q9- What is your opinion in the Reconciliation Movement headed by Dr. Sa'ad Rashed Al-Faqeeh, and how do you assess it?
- Q10- What is your advice today to the camp personnel towards the Islamic nation?
- Q11- What is our duty towards the instructors and what is your advice to the instructors towards the camp personnel?
- Q12- Dear Sheikh, please give advice to some brothers here amongst us who give lessons that focus on listening to and obeying the Emir. The fact among the men is that they are the most disobedient to the Emir. This as you well know result negatively on others.
- Q13- I want to pledge the legend to you to listen to and obey you in good and bad times. Please teach us what you know about Islam, and show us the proof and the way to migration and Jihad and how to die saving the word of God.

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Q14- Why don't you deploy the men to the areas on the Uzbek borders. Establish a camp to be a basis for the advance of the companies. If the people in the Islamic world hear that there is an advance on the Uzbek

borders then a concentration occurs for the men from all regions of the world keeping in mind that the American threat is less there?

- Q15- Is possible to commence Jihad soon in Uzbekistan?
- Q16- What is the latest news about the Taliban?
- Q17- What are the threats by the Americans?
- Q18- Viewing the verses of Jihad we find that hoping prevails over fear, fear from rejection fear from the evil omen of the sin. What is your advice?

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- Q19- You know about the Jews entering Yemen and being permitted to purchase land and homes, what is their plan behind this action and what is our duty towards this imperialistic action?
- Q20- Please give us some details about the companies and battalions you plan to form.
- Q21- Would you give a word to the men to encourage them to stay in this country after they finish the preparation training for what is awaiting them of work in the future under your leadership. Keep in mind that some say that if I am prepared I return home to find the necessary equipment and my way to Chechnya. By the way, there presence is no way less than their going to Chechnya.
- Q22- Dear Sheikh, we pledged the legend to you to work and join Jihad movement, we will not let down, we are the soldiers of God. Please explain to us the importance of martyrdom operations against the American infidels?

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Q23- Please talk about the idea of migration. Some brothers return home after preparation phase. What is your advice on this subject? Some men from the Arabian Peninsula say how do we migrate from the Holy land? What is the reason behind delaying the executing the attacks against the Americans, and will be executed soon, and what is our role in it?

Q24- Is it true that the United States asked you to make peace with them without either side harassing the other?

Q25- What is the advantage of moving the camps from one location to another knowing the enemy has the capability to detect the location of the camps anywhere it is. We all know that the Al-Jazirah TV station announced the movement of the terrorist camps to the area near Helmand?

Q26- You mentioned the story of the religion deserters and that fighting them be according to the existing conditions and situation. What about the matter of the deserter and infidel Mas'oud particularly some say that it is not his time but it is time to fight the assailant enemy. How do you reply? Q27- What about the Tajik and Uzbek battalion, we are anxious to hear some news about it?

Q28- What is the status of the Yemen scholars?

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Q29- Some brothers say that fighting the infidels is legal (inside the Al-Haram mosque in Mecca). The Koran verse states it is ok to fight them if they initiates the fighting and the brothers say to initiate the fighting. Please explain vagueness in this point.

Q30- Which has priority fighting in Chechnya or in the Arabian Peninsula?

Q31- We heard talk from some brothers about sheikh Al-Sudais because he was praying for the king, is that allowed?

Q32- What are the latest news about the battalion to be dispatched to Uzbekistan?

Q33- What are the latest news about Chechnya and the Islamic world and the bombardment, and what is your advice to us, and what is our duty today?

Q34- Is permitted if we see the Americans inside the Haram to kill them along with their guide?

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Q35- Has Al-Qa'eda under your command pledged the legend to the Islamic Imarah in Afghanistan? If so, how do you call for fighting the United States knowing that the Taliban did not hear of it for reasons concerning the security and stability of Afghanistan? We pray to God that He saves the Taliban.

Q36- Concerning the assassination operations, why do you object or in other words you don't see them suitable knowing that they eliminated many of the oppressors whether being rulers or Ministers. The Libyan, Algerian and Egyptian examples are the best proof to this fact.

Q37- What about stealing or confiscating the possessions and the properties of the ruling family in the Arabian Peninsula knowing that they are the most who stole from the Moslems. These properties could be used in Jihad against the infidels, against them and their regime, and in Jihad to kick the infidels from the Arabian Peninsula.

Q38- Is it legal to kill the security and army personnel in the Arabian Peninsula?

Q39- If the ruler is deemed to be an infidel then his government and every person employed in his government is deemed an infidel because they don't apply the Islamic sharia. Does this contradict the faith of the ancestors since we have an indicator from the Koran that Pharaoh and Haman and their soldiers were wrong?

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Q40- Do we judge the entourage the same way we judge the ruler? Do we deem prince 'Abdullh Bin 'Abd Al-'Aziz and prince Nayef and others with authority that they are infidels like king Fahad or not?

Q41- You know and we know the conflict between the ruling Saudi family, what is role and our role in this conflict?

Q42- What about your project to liberate Jerusalem, and are there new plans to unify the freedom fighters and act to bring the operation to a successful end?

Q43- It is common knowledge that lately the Masonic movement began to infiltrate many if not all the Arab countries. Is there some thing to do to halt it and confront it?

Q44- Is there a front similar to the Chechen front we could go to?

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Q45- What is our duty towards Palestine and the Al-Aqsa mosque, and what could we do to liberate this mosque?

Q46- Is the ruling on fighting on the side of the Taliban an individual or collective duty? If collective, is it ok to fight without permission from the parents?

Q47- We look forward for martyrdom operations like the ones in Nairobi and Dar Al-Salam, what are the characteristics of the man that is required to execute such operations?

Q48- Please explain to us the present status with the leaders of the infidels and their threats. Also please talk to us about the (ADVICE MEMO) submitted to you by the Americans.

Q49- What are the latest news about the Uzbek, and when are you going to open the front there and in Tajikistan and will we participate in it?

Q50- What is the ruling on killing the infidels in any place and in any country?

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(16) Various Questions:

- Q1- Please tell us the direction of these states meaning Islamic, Shiite, Christian and or Jewish (Azerbaijan, Georgia, Armenia).
- Q2- What is the reason behind Mojahidi Khalq opposition to Iran, what is their faith and who supports them?
- Q3- After the Iraqi war, an Iraqi radio station appeared called "Free Iraq Radio Station". What is the identity of this radio station and its location, and who is the main supporter and its goal?
- (TC: The name Abu 'Ubaidah is written on top of this question which only indicates that the question was asked by him).
- Q4- What are the military and economic characteristics of the Ji'hon river and could it be crossed or not?
- Q5- Any maneuvers in anticipation of terrorist operations in Kazakhstan and white Russia?
- Q6- Is Pope Paul for all Christians, and what about his upcoming visit to Palestine?

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(15) Questions Concerning Yemen

- Q1- What is the extent of your contact with Sheikh Al-Zindani at the present time? And is there a way to for him to join Jihad again?
- Q2- In Yemen, political security are kidnapping, raping and killing sisters who are spreading the word of Jihad. How do you advice our Yemeni brothers to deal with the situation knowing that at present they are being advised through the telephone.
- Q3- We heard that Sheikh Osama Bin Laden had a role in the war in Yamen and was the main reason for the break of war between the Northern army and the freedom fighters on one side and the communists on the other, and that he provided them with financial support. Is that true or not?

Q4- Would you give us an idea about your previous Jihad experience in Yemen?

Q5- What was the role of Yemeni tribes with Bin Laden during his Jihad period in Yemen during the 90's?

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Q6- Do you advice the Islamic movements to operate in Yemen and prepare for that? What in your opinion is the best method to unify the efforts of these movements and direct them properly?

Q7- We know that it is not time now for organized work in Yemen for reasons you only know. Could we know these reasons particularly we see the dangerous development in the region and the American occupation of some of the Yemeni islands in preparation for something greater, and methods of deception are being applied from all sides. I am afraid that the future will get worse and we will have no time for sorrow.

Q8- What is your opinion in what our brother the late Abu Al-Hasan Al-Mihdhar did? Do you agree with such action? Why there are no reactions against the world orders for his execution for the many benefits it would offer and result in?

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Q9- What is status of Yemen VIS A VIS the control of the new world order? And how does the West view Yemen? What are your future expectations of the Jewish – Christian alliance against Yemen?

Q10- What about the Jewish Rabbis' visits to Yemen?

Q11- When and how did the United States entered and took control over the Yemen island of Suqatra and was it actually sold to the United States?

Q12- You spoke in the past about the necessary preparations before announcing Jihad. Doesn't that contradict your Jihad announcement against the United States with one big difference in the numbers and equipment?

(14) Questions about the New World Order

Q1- A drop of water for a barrel of oil!!

Would the Sheikh give details and examples on the existing politics concerned with the war on future war over waters, and Perhaps the prophets' tradition about the Euphrates refluxing to reveal a mountain of gold has an assumption indication?

- Q2- You mentioned that political support of Serbia in its war against Bosnia came from (NATO). WE observed that the massacres of Kosovo were also caused by (NATO) where their bombardment destroyed the infrastructure in Serbia. What is your analysis of this situation?
- Q3- We heard in the past about the Kosovo problem and its massacres, and the same news were repeated few days ago. What is the nature of struggle in the area, and is it possible to say that the area is on its way to destructive wars particularly that Albania still containing a large percentage of Moslems?
- Q4- The U.N. Agriculture and Land Commissioner warned yesterday that the Middle East will continue to rely on foreign assistant in food supplies and said that the imports are ten times the exports. My question: Is the Middle East which possess the entire oil reserve threatened with famine?

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Q5- Did the Jews play a role in supporting the Serbs in the Bosnian war?

Q6- We hear about the International law, International Court and International Bank. What is the link between globalization and these entities? Please give us a summary about them?

- Q7-Is the success of globalization inside the Islamic countries and the failure of Arabic governments in front a large group of people inside the society that has become poorer. Is this a winning ticket for the Islamic movements particularly the ones calling for Jihad?
- Q8- The main pillar of globalization is economic control. Is there an Islamic movement specializing in economy?

- Q9- What is the fact about the (NATO) attacking the Serb in Kosovo? Please explain in details.
- Q10- What is meant by establishment of (Free Market) in the Arab Countries, and what is its danger for example in Yemen?

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- Q11- Dear Sheikh, Don't you see that public awareness in purchasing locally produced goods even if it is highly priced will relatively solve the globalization problem?
- Q12- What we see in Middle Eastern media written by some political analysts about Gulf capitol, Arab laborers and Israeli technology. Where did the matter settle? Did it surpass the commercial conferences attended by Israel?
- Q13- What are the points of weakness in the new world order?

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(13) Our State of Affairs and the Islamic Movements

- Q1- Dear Sheikh, Some brothers say that Sheikh 'Abd Al-Rahman Al-Sudais is a pig and a dog because he says that the freedom fighters are outlaws and could cause the imprisonment of some brothers in Najd and Hijaz due to the Fatwas he is issuing. What is your opinion in him?
- Q2- We realized our state of affairs and our occupation by the infidels with forces we are unable to defeat. How do you see we would be able to eliminate this occupation knowing that the population is not capable of lifting a hand to help and those capable are too far from occupied land?
- Q3- What is our duty in this world and what are the cautions we should take?
- Q4- In the past we find that the Moslem feared the American military power. Nowadays, military operations proves that it is possible to hit the enemy, but we are facing another problem being the cultural and intellectual invasion, and people became to love the Western civilization and the

I sat with one of the brothers associated with the Taliban and he told me that the population are beginning to tire from the Taliban because of their worsening behavior and they are beginning to express that Mas'oud is better than the Taliban. Isn't it better for the Taliban to eliminate these people to prevent the spread of Taliban hatred among the Afghani population?

Q6- We heard about the Shiites raping the female Moslem in Kabul and how they were imprisoned naked in underground tunnels when Kabul was under the control of Rabbani. The situation did not change until the Taliban entered Kabul. How true is this information and do you have any comments?

(TC: The name Abu 'Amr is written next to this question)

Q7- We heard that Sayaf will surrender to the Taliban soon. Is this information true?

Q8- Dear Sheikh, what are your comments on the following: 1-Dubai radio station: Afghanistan pulls its diplomats from Pakistan.

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Q9- Is a coup possible against the Taliban particularly since they are not in control of the situation yet?

- Q10- The Kuwaiti press agency reported that Iran called again to find a peaceful solution to the Afghani problem. What are the indications to this?
- Q11- How did we let the United States ride our backs after we destroyed Russia? Is it because every where we are being used as a bridge not only in Afghanistan, but in Bosnia. What should have the freedom fighters done? Fight those who stood in their way or not? Please give your opinion in some detail.
- Q12- Please explain to us if possible where does the Taliban stand from drug trafficking?

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- Q7- What prevents some Of Jihad leadership from pledging the legend to Mullah Muhammed 'Omar? Is there legal evidence to support them?
- Q8- The balance of military and political power in the side of the brothers gathered in Afghanistan. Their internal balance of power requires balancing. Are there actual serious steps to be taken to unify everyone?
- Q9- You know that every dissension is a disparity but every disparity is not a dissention, because there are various types of dispute from contradiction,

to comprehension to diversification disputes. As you well know the comprehension and diversification disputes are a healthy phenomena for the scientific, political, legal and realistic perception. But there is still dissension among the ranks of Arab freedom fighters. Do we understand from this dissension that it is of contradiction (superiority complex, meaning that it is supported with evidence and bias).

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Q10- The majority of Jihad movements (Al-Jihad, Al-Moqatalah, and Al-Jama'ah Al-Islamiyah) have reached a dead end road as I see it with the regimes in the countries where it operates. - 1- The Afghanistan (Khurasan) axis along with the strategic defensive depth in central Asia.
- 2- The Yemeni axis which provides the men, weapons and topography but lacks the leadership and the appropriate time, and the people of Najd and Hijaz (Saudi Arabia) will join.
- 3- The axis of Syria, being the crossroads, the gathering place and battlefields. Does retraction from a former strategic route means retraction from the principle of Jihad?

Try to bring back the Moslem nation from its deep sleep, and finding the right cures for illness before it is too late and this requires skilled physician and surgeon. People having the courage to point out to the leadership their mistakes without fearing the consequences of punishment).

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A Multitude of Advice Bequeath Suspicion

It is rather difficult to identify those who give advice from those who deceit.

- Introduction: Characteristics, manhood, and a yes-man.
- Subjects: Chaos, giving the opportunity, pledging the legend, benefits of preparing for preparation, battalions and companies, quantity, regular meeting, Al-Jhad and Al-Jama, and magazine, your media policy, application, etc.
- 1- Random chaos is prominent in the majority of the brothers' work even though we see a small percentage of organization which of course takes time. My question is: Is the nature of organization progressing in accordance with a phase planning within a comprehensive plan, or is it progressing randomly along with the

- events and priorities and requirements are assessed within the organization in accordance to the available actual facts.
- 2- Replacing some of the leadership to give the opportunity to others.
- 3- Give a chance to the people from the Arabian Peninsula residents of Yemen, Najd and Hijaz to work in surveillance only inside the Arabian Peninsula and adjacent areas.
- 4- Pledging the legend for Mullah Muhammed 'Omar and the extent of obligating those who pledged the legend to you. Some understood pledging the legend to Mullah Muhammed 'Omar ceasing activities against the United States.
- 5- The timing of people arriving to prepare for Jihad and your announcement at times of the existence of operations.
